

Languages, Literacy & Communication

Literacy

Through our topic, the children will use the text Lost and Found. The children will explore a variety of genres including, retelling the story, creating Lost and Found posters and use ICT to explore animation. They will also, look at stories from different cultures and persuasive texts to create leaflets for their Humanities project.

The children will develop their oracy skills by discussing their opinions and exploring theirs and others' points of view. They will continue to develop a range of punctuation and spelling/phonetic patterns.

Welsh

This term the children will explore the text Sinderlla. They will be practicing reading aloud independently and sequencing a dialogue and story. As part of the topic they will describe themselves and ask/answer questions such as What do you want to do? and Have you got.....?

Expressive Arts

Art As part of outdoor learning children will create spiral pictures using natural resources. The children will explore the work of Andy Goldsworthy.

Music

The children will explore different Transport poems and create patterns of music to add to their performance.

Mathematics & Numeracy

The children will complete lots of place value activities to develop secure understanding of the values of number. They will complete written methods of addition, subtraction, division and multiplication. This will be completed practically using a range of pictorial methods and linked to other areas of the curriculum to develop real - life opportunities and numeracy skills. The children will also complete position, direction and properties of 2D shapes. The focus for multiplications will be 2, 5 and 10 times tables. Through our daily math's activities we will also be practicing our number bonds to 100, place value, part models and problem solving skills.
