# <u>Languages</u>, <u>Literacy & Communication</u> <u>Literacy</u>

Through our topic, the children will use the text Lost and Found. The children will explore a variety of genres including, retelling the story, creating Lost and Found posters and use Purplemash to explore animation. They will also, look at stories from different cultures and persuasive texts to create leaflets for their Humanities project. The children will develop their oracy skills by discussing their opinions and exploring theirs and others' points of view. They will continue to develop a range of punctuation and spelling/phonic patterns. This term the children will also explore a range of Welsh phrases. They will be practising reading aloud independently and sequencing a dialogue and stories. As part of the topic they will describe themselves and ask/answer questions such as What do you want to do? and Have you got .....?

## Expressive Arts

<u>Art</u> -As part of outdoor learning, children will create clay models in the forest school area showing arrange of emotions. The children will also investigate different natural materials in art.

#### Music

The children will explore different Transport poems and create patterns of music to add to their performance.

# Mathematics & Numeracy

The children will complete lots of place value activities to develop secure understanding of the values of number. They will complete written methods of addition, subtraction, division and multiplication. This will be completed practically using a range of pictorial methods and linked to other areas of the curriculum to develop real - life opportunities such as budgeting for a meal in the Titanic. The children will also complete position, direction and properties of 2D shapes. The focus for multiplications will be 2, 5 and 10 times tables. Through our daily math's activities we will also be practicing our number bonds to 100, reasoning, part models and problem solving skills.

#### Humanities

## Science & Technology

#### Science

Science this term will allow investigations into materials and their uses, friction and gravity. STEM - The children will be exploring the most appropriate materials for their boats and investigate how different elements can affect their flying machines falling ICT/DCF - Communication and Coding

This term the children will be developing their skills through the use of HWB (Microsoft 360) and Purplemash. The children will develop their understanding of the purposes of the keys and also typing skills. Following this they will explore coding, through Purplemash challenges and the BeeBots

#### DT
