

## Dear Parents/Carers,

The Governing Body have made the decision to adopt the Local Authority's Attendance Policy. This means that we will be following Torfaen's Strive Attendance Framework and liaising with the Education Welfare Service to help us tackle persistent absenteeism. The Governing Body have taken this measure to fall in line with other schools in the Local Authority and to ensure a consistent approach to raising attendance levels across the authority. As you are aware, the school's attendance target is 95% and the local authority are continuing to drive the 'Strive for 95+' initiative through their #notinmissout campaign. Unfortunately, we are currently not on track to reach our target and this is largely due to the growing percentage of pupils whose current attendance is below 90% (which the LA class as persistence absenteeism).

Attendance and attainment are very closely linked, as outlined in the table below. Whilst we will continue to reward pupils for 100% attendance, we will also be sending out Stage 1 and Stage 2 letters where there are concerns about your child's attendance. We will also invite parents in to school to attend 'Attendance Improvement Meetings' if our concerns continue. We may also refer parents to the Education Welfare Service for further investigation, which could lead to fixed penalty notices being issued.
